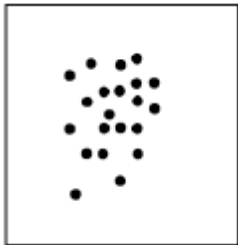
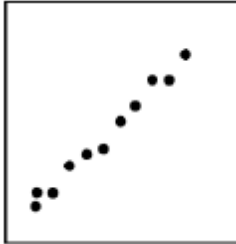


Station 3 – Interpreting Relations
